Veteran Dog 3

1st Cracknell's Sorata Bertie ShCM A Masculine black and tan boy shown in immaculate condition. A handsome head, sweet eyes and well placed ears set off his warm expression. Raven black coat with rich tan points, he glowed with condition. Stode out well.

2nd Lymer and Jones's Homerbrent Branscombe Lovely boy in super condition. With a well broken blenheim coat, ideal size and a sweet endearing face... I found him charming.

Minor Puppy Dog 3

1st Koster's Harana Gypsy King A delightful B&t baby boy at his first show. He took his courage in his paws and strode out around the ring showing his lovely frame, well set and carried tail and smooth stride. He possesses a lovely head, big dark eyes and flattish skull with a good finish to his muzzle. A lovely prospect. BPD

2nd Mynott's Honeybet Ricardo This little Blenheim was rather full of himself today. Good for size and bone and a promise of a lovely coat to come. Correct in head with flattish skull and tapered muzzle. When he settles to give a better account of himself it will be easier to see his lovely front and movement.

3rd Barwell's Charlottetown Galileo Gold NAF

Junior Dog 6

1st Ireland's Charnell Hogan Masculinity and moderation is what this blenheim toy spaniel said to me at initial inspection. His balance between fore and rear angles with a strong firm topline is what immediately gives him an advantage in a class; he has the silhouette of the breed. Add to this his rich colour, silky coat and then his head....a flattish skull, large dark and well placed eyes and gently tapered muzzle... he ticks the boxes. As the day wore on his oomph fizzled out. BD and RBIS

2nd Homes Leogem Renaissance A super glamorous exhibit with a correct front, firm topline and a beautiful, silky Blenheim coat. A tad over angulated in the rear for ideal balance. Moved with purpose, light-footed and parallel. Head is pretty but perhaps not as masculine as the winner. Lovely warm expression from his round, well placed eyes. A quality exhibit.

Graduate Dog 5

1st Levy, Sedgewick and Cline's Pascavale Masquerade a neat and pretty little dog, so willing to show off his qualities. This well marked tricolour is very well made, has great angles and a rock solid topline. His head is full with a shallow stop and his ears well placed on top, eyes large and dark giving a lovely warm expression. The silkiest textured coat on show today. A real glamour boy!

2nd Brymarden Honeycombe of Judyland Unlucky to meet two strong contenders in junior as he is a very handsome lad. A little bigger all over than the principle winners but beautifully marked and full of quality. His head is very attractive.

3rd Wileman and Bott's Ellemich Konstantino of Narvidar

Post Graduate Dog 3

1st Godwin's Simpatico Sage Pretty black and tan boy of good size and type, sweet head, a strong topline, good front and a great willingness to perform ..won him this class. Lacked coat today but it only served to show his good shape on the move.

2nd Morgan's Hearthfriends Top Withens An attractive tricolour who moved smartly with a good topline, excellent show temperament.

3rd Richmond's Charlottetown New Approach

Sp.Limit Blen or Tri 5

1st Knight's Carolus Don Santino JW ShCM This blenheim ticks plenty of boxes with his compact shape, well broken coat, good front, excellent ribbing and firm topline. He carries his tail well on the move and really strides out. He has a handsome head, flattish skull, neat lips giving a pleasing mild expression. A quality exhibit.

2nd Wightman's Ellemich Kenzo at Kailyflee JW A super glamorous young man that I have met before with the prettiest of faces, a wealth of well marked coat and a real 'look at me' attitude, he catches the eye; a real toy spaniel. He just didn't move or carry himself as well as the winner.

3rd Mangham's Castlewytch Perfection of Charnavale JW

1st Towse's Miletree Solo A youthful blenheim boy with a well balance frame and good angles giving an excellent silhouette. His head is appealing, round dark eyes and his ears are on top of a flattish skull, jet black pigment. Went smartly with his tail well held. A tpy boy.

2nd Knight's Carolus Don Ricco JW ShCM Lovely exhibit with a very appealing head with super eyes, short strong topline and of ideal size. Not looking as good today as I've seen him.

3rd Evan's Evansly Endeavor

Sp Open bred by exh Dog 3

1st Barwell's Charlottetown Cecil Such a correctly made blenheim cavalier with super angles and tail set, excellent ribbing and precise movement. Sadly lacking in coat and featherings.

2nd Evan's Evansly Earnest A tad bigger than the winner, longer in loin but beautifully marked and well coated. A very willing showman who moved so well.

Veteran Bitch 5

1st Homes Leogem Musetta The epitome of a mature yet still glamorous cavalier female. Her topline is firm and short and this lovely lady was good on the move. Her face has lost none of its prettiness and she showed very proficiently to BVIS

2nd Koster's Dortmund Delyla Harana Another glamour Puss. A tad older than the winner and yet so full of beans. Her head is delightful with those sparkling eyes and well carried profuse ears. Went like a bomb. A close decision.

3rd Dawson's Willowtump Athelas at Luphenex

Minor puppy Bitch 5

1st Homes Leogem Ginestra Now THIS is an exciting prospect. A delightful baby at her first show, full of enthusiasm for the task, she showed her socks off. Her outline is excellent from the beautiful balance of her angles and her short firm topline. Her head is pretty with round dark eyes, long well placed ear leathers and a good finish to her muzzle. With the promise of a glamorous coat on its way, this powerful moving puppy looks set to shine. RBB and BPIS

2nd Godwin's Pennygown Nuts in May I liked this pretty headed little ruby, so shapely and tpy. I thought at times she looked short on leg but on the move she looked very well balanced and came into her own. An excellent rear on this girl.

3rd Koster's Harana Emmaline

Puppy Bitch 7

1st Maclaine's Pennygown Ticket to Ride I loved the expression on this youngster, the way she carries her head on a well arched neck, her lovely front and excellent ribbing. She has round dark eyes, a well tapered muzzle, flattish skull and a harmonious blend of these attributes. With a well textured coat coming, the future looks bright for this girl.

2nd Towse's Miletree Ophelia Close decision between these two youngsters, this one is better marked and both are full of quality. Ophelia has a pretty, ultra feminine head with a warm sweet expression. The winner had slightly better rear angulation and moved more fluently on the day but this one has much appeal.

3rd Glenn's Shelpet Samara at Lilorchard

Junior Bitch 3

1st Brewer and Moody's Charlottetown Star Turn A pretty blenheim girl, neat and glamorous and in full silky coat. I liked her shape and her sassy attitude with constant wagging tail. Her head is pretty with warm sparkling eyes but a bit short in muzzle for correctness.

Novice Bitch 4

1st Maclaine's Pennygown Ticket to Ride (as puppy)

2nd Homes Leogem Aliona A blenheim bitch with nice big dark eyes. No doubting her sex, utterly feminine and very prettily marked but reluctant to lift her ears and complete the picture. Moved very fluently.

3rd Gore's Aristor's Rosanna

Graduate Bitch 6

1st Surman's Pennygown Madly deeply for Vallender A lovely mature bitch with much glamour and style. Her expression is charming with lovely eyes, well padded muzzle and super pigment. Very well ribbed and coated, she went with panache.

2nd Brewer and Moody's Bowfort Patacake Another girl with a pleasing head, so beautifully coated and light and purposeful on the move.

3rd Vout's Khatibi Touch of Class at Touvas

Post Graduate Bitch 3

1st Vout's ChlojadeMoondust over Touvas A black and tan girl of larger proportions. She is beautifully coated in jet black coat with good tan points. Soon settled and gave a good account of herself on the move.

Sp Limit Blen or Tri Bitch 5

1st Vella's Cinderaic The Lady is a Tramp The face on this tricolour bitch captivated me. Delicious big, dark, round eyes sparkling from this charming face made me melt. Her well filled muzzle, neat lips and beautifully carried ears only enhanced her appeal. On the move she is a knock out. Those angles and super topline propelled her around with aplomb. This bitch deserves high honours in my opinion and the lack of an additional splash of white is of nothing in a bitch of this quality **BB and BIS**

2nd Mangham's Charnavale Magic Touch Ultra pretty blen girl, fully coated silky and well marked. Nice front, good ribbing and firm quarters. Her head is sweet with pretty eyes and correct

proportions. Moved positively. 3rd Brewer and Moody's Charlottetown Silvee at Bowfort

Sp Limit B&t or Ruby Bitch 3

1st Maclaine's Lochbuie Reddy for Anything Such a charming ruby girl who comes together on the move. Her construction really assists her to hold a pleasing shape all the way around. Topline and tail carriage first class, she moved parallel. Bright pretty eyes and flattish skull give her a pleasing face which can only be enhanced with a bit more fill to her muzzle in maturity.

2nd Vout's ChlojadeMoondust over Touvas (see PG bitch)

3rd Vout's Khatibi Lazy Gaga at Touvas

Open 2

1st Surman's Cavaleigh Lillian A pretty Blenheim bitch in full bloom. Nicely constructed and coated, she moved out fluently. Her head is pretty and nicely balanced. A pleasing exhibit.

2nd Vout's Khatibi Lazy Gaga at Touvas Black and tan who tried hard for her handler, moved smoothly on the go around. Sweet face.

Sp Open bred by Exh 1

1st Vella's Cinderaic Taboo I've loved this little bitch for some time and was rather disappointed to see that not only had she lost all her coat ...but with it, some of her condition. She has the loveliest shape, ideal size and with a rock solid topline. Her head is delightful, lustrous eyes, well filled muzzle and elegantly carried ears. Her best show days are to come I'm sure. Keeping girls in show condition can be frustrating.
